The purpose of the "Direction Space" festival is creating an educational platform for theatre directors of a new generation, enriching young student directors' background through dialogue with masters of professional theatre, with colleagues from other cities of Russia as well as from abroad, with representatives of allied professions: playwrights, directors, critics, actors, producers, artists, architectures, composers.

The festival introduces young professional directors to performances of prominent theatre masters, presents a programme of discussions, lectures, workshops, seminars, and gives students of theatre schools an opportunity to get an experience of interacting with the team of a professional theatre - actors, artists, technicians - in the course of the Young Director Laboratory.

Each festival performance is presented by a moderator – a representative of a theatre profession: director, actor, critic, producer, artist, etc. The moderator also leads the discussion after the performance, involving the audience.

The idea of the production is inspired by Anton Makarenko's work and the book by Konstantin Stanislavsky "The Actor's Work on Himself". These two books are united by the topic of moral education and both attempt to reveal the complex relationship of an individual with society. The books bring to the foreground the intensive work of a person on his own personality, the person's constant need for reflection and interest in the life around, stimulated, as revealed in the works of Makarenko and Stanislavsky, not by a feeling of duty, but that of responsibility, responsibility to oneself, and also to the whole world.

YOUNG DIRECTOR AND PROFESSIONAL THEATRE

Sketch performances, discussions:

Artistic Leader of the Laboratory – Principal Director of Perm Academic Theatre-Theatre Vladimir Zolotar.

Work in the Laboratory consists of two stages. First several student directors from Russia as well as from Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania, come one week before the festival, start working on sketches of performances based on the material chosen by themselves. The main point is that this is the first experience of young directors with the team of professional theatre – costumers, property-masters, set designers, and, of course, actors. Young directors get this type of experience beyond the usual educational frame, in real existing conditions, for the first time. The second stage: on the first day of the festival the sketches of performances are to be presented for professional judgment. The participants of the festival, students and graduates of Institutes of Art and Culture, along with a jury made up of directors, producers and critics discuss the works presented. The jury chooses the winner of this young directors' competition, and Theatre-Theatre concludes a contract with the winner, giving the young director the right to stage a production in the next theatre season.
